FINAL JURY REQUIREMENT LIST **(SUBMISSION: 30.05.2017)**

The tasks listed below are products of group work. The groups work on their specified neighbourhoods.

Each group is asked to submit the requirement list below for their respective area:

1. Figure & ground analysis (block/streets; building/lot) **1/5000**
2. Old & new analysis (historical/new buildings, historical/new sites) **1/5000**
3. Land use analysis (The legend for land use study is given below.) **1/5000**
4. Morphological analysis (densities of buildings; low/medium/high rise; attached/detached/semi-detached buildings; etc.) **1/5000**
5. Environmental analysis (wind/sun directions, topography, green areas, water sources, etc.) **1/5000**
6. Circulation analysis (vehicle/pedestrian density during the day/night time, rush hours; accessibility, public transportation, etc.) **1/5000**
7. Conceptual and spatial analyses for the proposed master plans of the specified neighbourhoods **1/5000** (more than three, including groups' proposals in diagrams for open, semi-open, closed public spaces, greenery, circulation and transportation paths etc.)
8. Master Plan for the neighbourhood / to be proposed with a project name appropriate for the conceptualization and development of the project) **1/1000**

Note that each group is asked to study the site boundaries of their neighbourhood in relation to the site boundaries of Batıkent, and Batıkent in relation to the site boundaries of Ankara Greater Municipality.

SUBMISSION FORMAT

A0 posters (vertical side should be fit to A0, you can extend the poster on the horizontal axis as much as you wish) including the code and name of the course and instructor, semester information, group number and the name of the students in the group in an alphabetical order.

RECREATIONAL FACILITIES (open/semi-open air recreational activities, differentiating in color tones sports and other leisure areas like roller skating or ice skating facilities)

EMPTY SPACES (unused empty spaces, differentiating in color tones open, semi-open or closed empty spaces and blocks)
